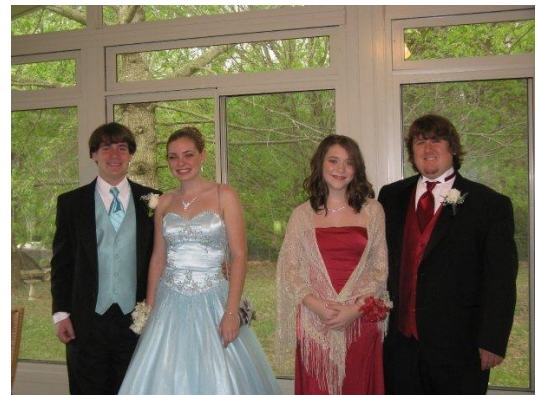
in Elementary Education. She is currently working at a pre-school in Auburn. She is a wonderful addition to our family!
